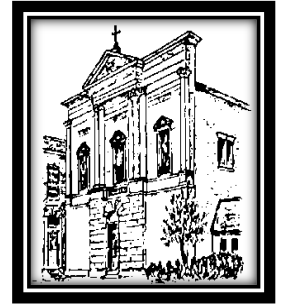

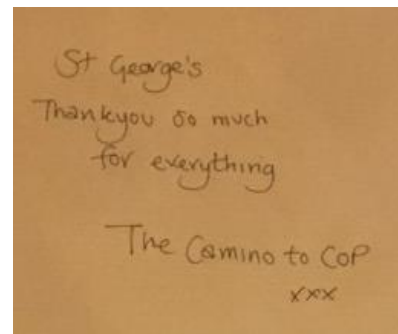
Camino to COP26 – a thank you
